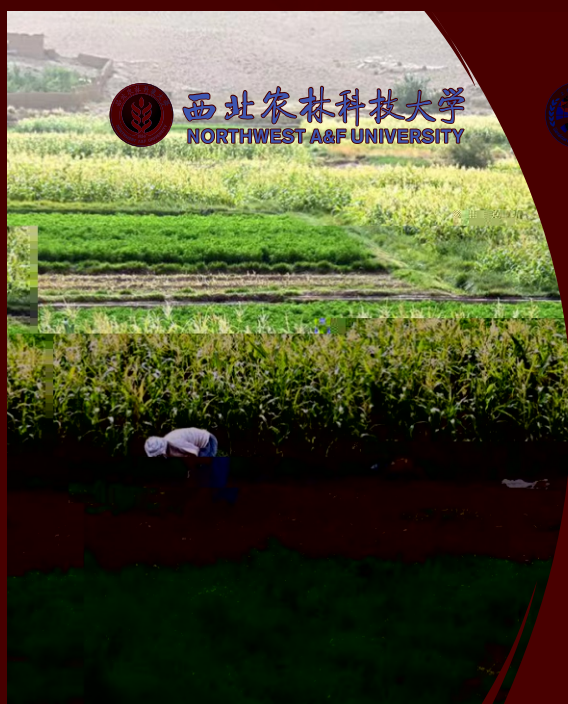

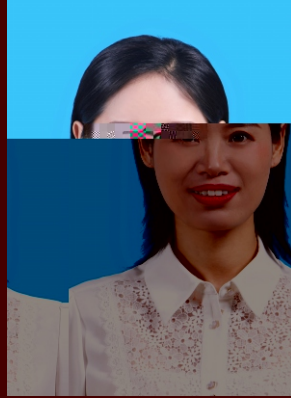

Wang Hongmei
